Titusville City Council Meeting 01-24-2023

There was a 5:30 meeting that lasted 2 hours, involving many presentations. From legalities to financials, to technology in the police department. If you have time to watch it, some of those presentations were very informative.

- ❖ -The Historical Preservation Board gave their semi-annual report. They have a booklet, a website, and a phone app to help you explore all the historical buildings in Titusville!
- ❖ -Planning and Zoning board turned in their semi annual report.
- ❖ -The Titusville Environmental Commission did a semi annual presentation.
- ❖ -The Titusville Flag and Memorial Committee turned in their semi-annual report.
- ❖ -North Brevard Economic Zone Titusville Member Alan Matroni resigned from the board. Edna Wilson was selected to replace Mr. Matroni.
- ❖ -Planning and Zoning Commission had multiple appointments and one moment of controversy which will be resolved at the next council meeting.
- ❖ -Yvette Flis was appointed to the Titusville Environmental Commission.

Tonight I presented a program I call R.A.I.L.S. Meant to create city revenue and reduce taxation. Unfortunately, the council had no discussion following the presentation and just said "Thank You." I will attach that presentation to this for all to see and you can discuss it.

#### Consent Agenda:

- ❖ -Approve Titusville Investment Policy update.
- ❖ -Joined an HIV class action litigation
- ❖ -\$41,437.00 in City HOME CHDO grant funds.
- ❖ -\$373,096.84 spent on engineering consulting services for Laboratory Facility renovations.
- ❖ -Approve the transfer of \$10,120 ARPA funds that were given to Catholic Charities of Central Florida and transfer them to the Boys and Girls club.
- ❖ -Approval or road closures for Sculptor Charter School's 5K run event.

-Stormwater Technical Manual was amended. As well as an administration Risk Management Program.

-The RV dealer downtown requested a change in the zoning laws to allow him to store RVs on his property when people drop them off for repair. The law requires 300' between the edge of their property and a house. But the closest house is about 150 feet away so the ordinance would be changed from 300 to 100. Nothing came of this. They will discuss it again at the next meeting.

-After 10:30 I had to leave. I have an early day tomorrow. All that's left is the approval of Tranquility Bay phase 2 and the board reports. Thank You for reading!
